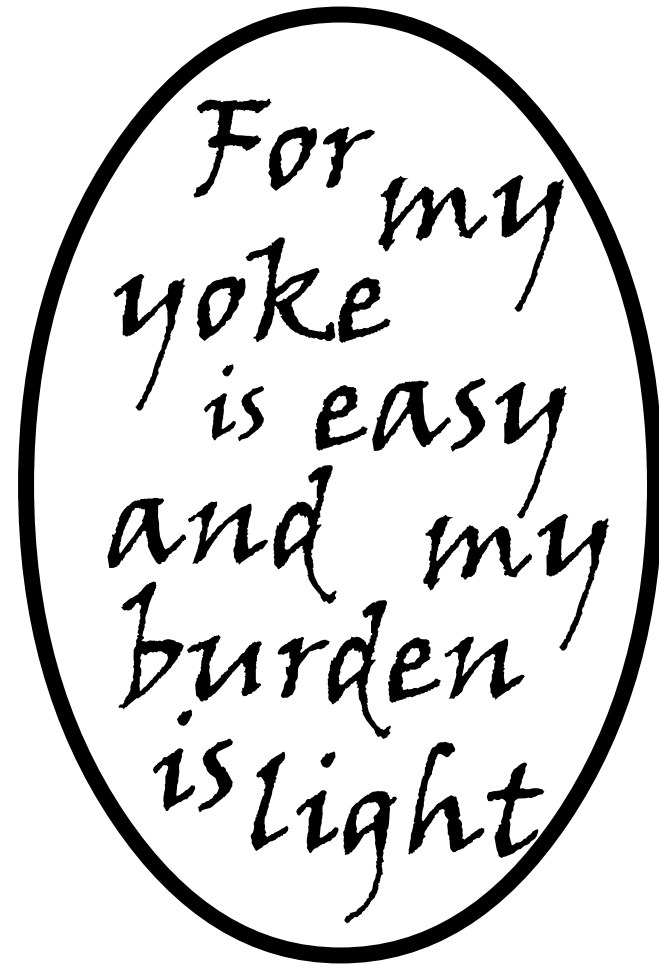

Mennonite Mutual Aid is grateful it can support so many congregations, individuals, and families with grants during these times. Due to this increased demand, however, the Sharing Fund has, effective June 18, 2009, used up its available funds for this year. Typically, the Sharing Fund does not run out of funds until autumn of each year. MMA still has money available to process Premium Assistance Grants (for MMA health plans) and the Will Benefit Grants. Due to the extreme need caused by the national economic situation, MMA has designated \$50,000 beyond the usual Sharing Fund budget to create a special Faith in the Future Grant to help people in need due to the current economic downturn. This special grant will be available only in 2009. This grant is a three-to-one matching grant. For every \$3 a church gives toward a need, MMA will contribute \$1.
