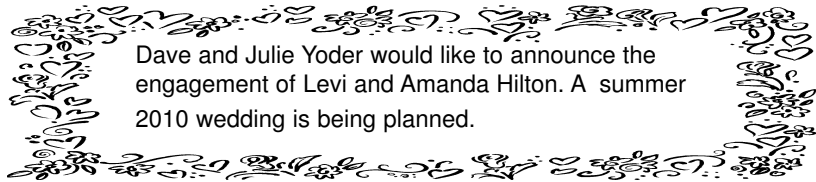
- Continue to pray for Willie and Donita Garber as they make decisions concerning Donita's health.
